**1 Update Family/Student Information**

\*Update Student/Family Information, such as a change in address, a new phone number, your pick-up list, or an email address, on RenWeb. Complete a new pick-up form (one per family) and a new medical release form for each student attending GRACE.

**2 Choose your Payment Plan**

- Annual (June 1, 2017)
- Semi-Annual (June 1, 2017 & December 1, 2017)
- Monthly (June 1, 2017 - May 1, 2018)

**3 Sign this sheet and return with your \$140 re-enrollment fee (per student), pickup list, and medical release form(s) by Feb. 14, 2017**

***\*After Feb. 14th, re-enrollment fee increases to \$275 per student.***

\*\*SPECIAL OFFER! Families who pay their re-enrollment fees on or before February 14, 2017 and make their June tuition payments on time will NOT experience an increase in tuition. PLEASE NOTE: Tuition prices are determined by the grade level of your child. You may still experience a tuition increase if your child moves to a different grade tier. Example: A student promoted from 5th grade to 6th grade. Don't delay! Late enrolling students will be billed using the new student tuition pricing. Dear Parents,

Re-enrollment season is upon us, and once again we will have limited enrollment throughout Grace Christian Academy. So please sign up immediately if you plan on returning next year. Many students were turned away last year, and we anticipate this happening again.

Grace Christian Academy's vision statement remains, "Grace is the place to change students' lives so they can be a transforming influence on their world for Jesus Christ". In order to accomplish this mission, we must have quality families, faithful to their evangelical local church, who completely agree and support this vision. I believe that our families are the perfect fit for our ministry.

After much consideration and discussion, the Grace leadership team agrees that our current families are the best way to attract likeminded people. For this reason, Grace will again be offering families incentives for referring new students (other than siblings) who make it through our admissions process. You may think, "What types of families make it through the enrollment process?" We are confident that the answer is, "Families like yours, with children like yours".

The incentive for quality enrollment is as follows: For every family that you recommend who makes it through the admission process, \$500.00 will be credited towards your tuition for the upcoming year. This will be credited to your account over a course of 12 months. The enrolling family must indicate on enrollment materials which Grace family has recommended them. Please keep in mind that every family that applies may not make it through our process. As a matter of fact, most new candidates did not make it through the enrollment process for the last few years. Admission to Grace is determined solely by the Grace admission's team.

Please remember to return your Grace re-enrollment forms by February 14 to qualify for the \$140.00 enrollment fee (per student). After this date the fee goes up to \$275.00 per enrolling student. Open enrollment begins on March 1<sup>st</sup>.

Dear GRACE Families:

It's that time of year again when we begin in earnest to prepare for the upcoming school year. We must project our staff and resource needs as accurately as possible for the 2017-18 school year. A school's financial viability and quality of education depend upon making wise decisions six months before a new school year begins. Good stewardship of this awesome responsibility given to us demands that we never financially over extend ourselves with more staff and resources than we can sustain without going into debt. We are committed to offering a debt-free ministry to those who have graciously entrusted their children to us.

So, this letter is to share with you the decisions made by our leadership team with regard to next year's fees and tuition. We are not planning any tuition increase for new or returning families, but have determined once again to leave the tuition schedule the same for our current families who reenroll by February 14, 2017.

As in previous school years, we are offering an incentive for reenrolling before the deadline of February 12<sup>th</sup>. Those who reenroll by that date will only pay an enrollment fee of \$140 per student and will maintain their current tuition schedule. Please keep in mind, however, that you may see an increase in tuition if your child moves up to the next grade level tier. For example, a student moving from K5 to 1<sup>st</sup> grade would see an increase in tuition. Grade level tiers are: K3, K4, K5, 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>. Below is a table to show how the enrollment fee increases after February 12<sup>th</sup>.
